



Applying For Your Licence

The application form can be found by going to the AKA website www.karting.net.au and selecting 'Apply for Licence' from the top right-hand corner of the screen. Complete the application form step by step and include your photo if you can or supply a passport size photo with your payment. Payment and photo must be received before our licencing officer will process your licence. Please ensure that you include an email address so that your ID Number and password can be emailed direct to you.

Print out the final page which has a reference number A???? (Application form) then contact our licencing officer on licence@cckc.org.au . You must provide the following to the licence officer before a Temporary licence can be issued:

- Printed and signed Application form
- Photo if you couldn't attach in application if you are emailing this needs to be in Jpeg format so that we can edit the photo if need be
- Copy of birth certificate if under 18
- Medical if over 60 years and letter from their doctor if you have ticked a yes in the medical declaration.
- Completed Pit Crew Waiver forms with photos if applicable(this will need to be a printed passport size photo (drivers do not need to complete this form) we recommend that all pit crew get a card or you will have to sign a form and wear an arm band each race meeting. Pit Crew Cards are Valid for 12 months
- Payment or Payment Details if paying by Credit Card or Direct Deposit, This information to written on the membership form
- Previous Motorsport Experience Form if applicable(this has to be sent away for AKA Q approval)
- Membership form Page 1 (this form can be found on www.cckc.org.au under forms, Licence pricing can also be found on page 2 of this form)

Midget Drivers that are using a Yamaha J Motor require a restrictor plate please indicate on your printed application form if you are running this motor type. The restrictor is required at all times including practice if your kart does not have one already please advise the licence officer as we have them in stock so you can start practicing straight away

Those using a Comer SW80 Motor you do not need a restrictor.

Rookie Drivers will automatically receive a restrictor with your licence, if you require a restrictor to practice please advise the licence officer as we have them in stock so you can start practicing straight away

Senior Drivers for 125 Restricted Class are required to have at all times a restrictor, the cost of the restrictor is \$25.00 this must be added to the cost of your licence.

Please indicate on your Printed Application form your Engine type eg. **Fireball, Rotax, Leopard, Leopard x30 or Cheetah**. If you require a restrictor to practice please advise the licence officer as we have them in stock so you can start practicing straight away.
